

Dragan Teodosiev is a prominent jazz drummer from Macedonia, known for his versatile improvisational skills and dynamic performances. His style blends traditional jazz rhythms with contemporary influences, and he's recognized for his creative flair both as a performer and composer. Teodosiev's presence on the Macedonian music scene spans nearly two decades, during which he has collaborated with numerous artists and bands, including Taxi Consilium, Zarina Prvasevda, Yordan Kostov, Odron Ritual Orchestra, Dina Jashari and Shock Troopers.

In 2023, he won the prestigious "Best Young Macedonian Jazz Musician" award at the Skopje Jazz Festival, solidifying his reputation as one of the most talented young musicians in the country. Beyond Macedonia, Teodosiev has performed across Europe and worked with international groups, including the Belgian theater group "Madame Fortuna" .

His involvement in various musical projects showcases his adaptability and passion for pushing the boundaries of jazz.

Teodosiev's drumming style is a vibrant fusion of jazz traditions and modern improvisational techniques. He draws heavily from the rhythmic structures of jazz but expands them through contemporary influences, including experimental and avant-garde sounds. Known for his energetic and nuanced approach to percussion, Teodosiev seamlessly shifts between complex polyrhythms, dynamic tempo changes, and deep grooves, giving his music a rich, layered texture.

He often combines traditional jazz drumming techniques with more abstract sounds, utilizing the full range of his drum kit to create both subtle and powerful effects. His improvisational style is a standout feature, characterized by fluid transitions between intricate patterns and spontaneous bursts of creativity. This makes him not only a skilled performer but also a thoughtful composer who carefully crafts the rhythmic foundation of his pieces.

Teodosiev's versatility is evident in his collaborations, where he adapts his playing to a variety of genres and ensembles, from jazz to world music, experimental theater, and extreme metal. This adaptability and his distinctive voice as a percussionist have earned him recognition on both national and international stages.
